

## Thoughtful Branches Watercolour Hydrangea Instructions

1. I started with a piece of watercolour paper and sprayed it quite liberally with a water sprayer bottle (about 3-4 sprays from about 15 cm away)



2. I put a few drop of re-inker of four colours into a palette: Pink Pirouette, Rose Red, Wisteria Wonder and Perfect Plum.



3. Using an Aqua painter (Page 180 in the Annual Catalogue) squeeze a few drops of water into the Pink Pirouette one, and make a watery wash. Flick the aquapainter onto the wet watercolour paper.



4. Repeat with Rose Red, adjusting how much water you add based on the depth of colour you want.



5. This is the Wisteria Wonder layer.



6. This is the Perfect Plum layer.



7. After all the layers have been added, I dried the entire sheet off thoroughly using my heat gun (don't worry if it warps a bit).
8. I decided I wanted to add some gold highlights so I gold embossed one of the splatter images from Gorgeous Grunge stamp set over part of the sheet.



9. I then die cut the flower top using the Thinits and attached using some glue dots.
