### Triangle 3D Christmas Card using Stitched Triangle Dies

*Today we are making a 3D stand up Christmas card, that also folds down to fit into a C6 envelope. It has a magnetic closure and you can decorate it any way you like. You can either use the Stitched Triangle dies for cutting the DSP, or I have given you the measurements in the instructions.*

You will also need and adhesive metal closure (two adhesive discs) which are available in craft stores. Alternatively you can put a star or Christmas tree where the front edge folds over, and tuck the edge behind that to hold in place,

## Measurements:

- 3 squares of Red Cardstock 10cm x 10cm
- 2 pieces of coordinating DSP 20cm x 10cm each
- Pool Party cardstock for die cutting
- Scrap Whisper White cardstock for sentiment

## Step by Step Instructions:

1. Start with three 10x10cm squares of Real Red cardstock and score diagonally down the centre of each piece.



2. Adhere one edge of the Real Red cardstock to the score line of the piece on the left.




3. Do the same with the third piece. Fold both outer triangles inwards and burnish with your bone folder.



4. Fold the centre fold inwards as well, and burnish that with your bone folder.

5. Using the largest Stitched Triangle Framelit (the one that measures 9cm on the 2 shortest edges) and cut four pieces from one of the patterned papers. If you don't have these Stitched Triangle Dies, Cut 2 squares 9cm x 9cm and cut diagonally down the centre to form the 4 pieces.



6. Attach these to the four outside triangles.

7. Repeat step 5 with the other patterned paper and attach these pieces to the 4 triangles in the centre
8. Attach one of the magnetic closure pieces to the top left of the inside as shown.



9. Close the card so that it stands up by itself. Mark where the other magnetic piece needs to be on the outside of the card and adhere that.



10. Decorate the front of the card using die cuts from the Stitched Stars dies and Pool Party cardstock.
11. Adhere the blue adhesive dots to add some bling to the stars.



12. Stamp the greeting from Wrapped in Christmas in Real Red onto a strip of Whisper White cardstock 3/4" or 1.9cm wide
13. Make a decorative end on each side using the Lovely Labels Pick a Punch (leave enough room to add a Blue Adhesive Gem each side)



6. Stand the card up again and decide where to place the greeting. Adhere with Dimensionals.
