Today I am sharing with you a set of four notecards you can make with a stamp set which is featured in the 2020 Beginners Brochure, called Four Season Floral. It's only \$24AUD and is great to colour with Watercolour Pencils. I have shown these supplies on the next page

You can also buy the Four Season Stamp Set Project Collection with note cards, envelopes, ink, adhesive, and an acrylic block. This costs \$80.AUD

Alternatively, just use basic notecards and envelopes like I have . You can get a set of 20 cards in envelopes in either [Whisper White](#) or [Very Vanilla](#) for \$12.25AUD. The cards are sized 12.7 x 8.9cm. They are great for batch cards and very economical!



To make the cards up exactly as mine, I have also used:

- [Black Stazon ink pad](#) (so that the outlines won't run when you blend)
- [Blender Pens](#) to blend the pencil colouring
- A stamp or die cut for the vase (I used one from [Jar of Flowers](#) stamp set and stamped in Basic Grey)
- [Jar punch, and Jar of Flowers stamp set](#) for the mason jar (I used Crumb Cake ink on Crumb Cake Card)
- [Linen Thread](#)
- Scraps of patterned paper or doilies
- A Christmas sentiment stamp for the Poinsettia one (I used and LOVE the [Itty Bitty Christmas](#) stamp set)
- You will need the basic tools of a [Paper Trimmer](#) and [Paper Snips](#).
- You will need basic [adhesives](#) (I like the Stampin' Seal or Multipurpose Glue) plus Dimensionals
- [Stitched Rectangle dies](#) are optional (you can just cut using the measurements I give for each card over the page.

What I did for each card:

Card 1



- Stamp the vase from Jar of Flowers in Basic Gray onto a scrap of Whisper White cardstock.
- Stamp flowers in Stazon onto another scrap of Whisper White. Watercolour the flowers with pink and orange shades of pencils, and green for the leaves. Blend with Blender Pens, and cut out using Paper Snips. Adhere to the vase with Dimensionals (foam dots) to lift up a bit.
- Stamp the For You greeting in Black Stazon.
- Cut out with a Rectangle Stitched Die, but you could just cut it with paper trimmer. Size is 4.5cm x 8cm.
- Cut a vellum doily in half. Colour it with Stampin' Blends (I used Rococo Rose). When dry, attach to back of stamped piece so about 1cm is showing.
- Attach all this to the base notecard!

Card 2



Card 3

This one is the same as the previous card except:

- The greeting is stamped directly on the notecard (if you stuff up the stamping, just stamp again on a scrap and cut out and adhere over it—don't ask me why I know that so well, lol).
- Flower is coloured with yellow, and a bit of orange (depends on what set of pencils you have to exactly which Stampin Up colour).
- The stamped piece is cut to 8.2cm x 3.2cm



This one is the same as the previous card except:

- Flower is coloured with Calypso Coral(depends on which set of pencils you have to exactly which Stampin Up colour).
- The stamped piece is cut to 8.2cm x 3.2cm (same as last one).
- DSP piece is 4.6cm x 6cm
- Sentiment is stamped in matching ink colour (Old Olive and was cut as a separate piece and adhered (as I stuffed up the direct stamping, lol)

Card 4



- Stamp the jar from Jar of Flowers in Crumb Cake onto a scrap of Crumb Cake cardstock. And cut out with the jar punch.
- Tie some linen thread around the top of the jar and adhere flat to the notecard.
- Stamp flowers in Stazon onto a scrap of Whisper White. Watercolour the flowers with pink and red shades of pencils, green for the leaves and deep red for the berries.
- Blend with Blender Pens, and cut out using Paper Snips. Adhere above the jar with Dimensionals (foam dots) to lift up a bit.
- Stamp the greeting from Itty Bitty Christmas in Old Olive or another green ink.
- Cut out with the paper snips and adhere to the jar and card as shown.
