Circle Window 3 Panel Fold Card

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Today we are a card using a design I came up with and struggled to name, so just described it! I wanted something that could tie closed with ribbon or Bakers Twine. It also has lots of panels to allow for decoration and writing too. I have used the Water Lily stamps, dies and paper in the Saleabration catalogue, but the design could easily be adapted to other papers and bundles. I am sure someone special would appreciate this card.

Measurements

Cardstock

Coastal Cabana 14.85cm x 27.5cm, plus scraps for die cutting

Blushing Bride: 3 pieces 9.2cm x 14.55cm, plus scraps for die cutting


Whisper White: 9.2 x 14.55cm, plus scraps for die cutting

Lily Impressions Designer Series Paper

2 pieces 9.0 x 14.35cm

Step by Step Instructions

1. Cut the Coastal Cabana cardstock to size and score at 9.5cm and 19.5cm left to right on the longest side.
2. Fold both folds inwards and burnish with your bone folder for a crisp fold.
3. Emboss the right side panel with the Subtle embossing folder.
4. Using the second largest die from the stitched shapes dies, cut a circle in the top half of the far right panel (on the reverse side so the indent from the die shows on the front).
5. Keep the die cut piece to use for embellishment on the inside of the card.
6. Attach a piece of the Blushing Bride cardstock (9.2cm x 14.55cm) to the reverse of the left panel using Snail or Multipurpose glue. Leave the left and top side not adhered at this stage (until you have added the ribbon in the next picture).
7. Attach the DSP on top of this (this one can be attached on all sides).
8. Wrap a piece of Bermuda Bay ribbon 16cm long through the die cut circle and around the narrow piece of cardstock. Secure with tape (this will be covered on both sides).
9. Adhere the second piece of ribbon with tape underneath the Blushing Bride cardstock on the left hand side.
10. Fully adhere the rest of the Blushing Bride cardstock now.



11. Stamp some lily's onto Whisper White cardstock using Blushing Bride ink. Cut these out with the Lily Pad Dies.
12. Cut out some of the outline lily dies in Blushing Bride cardstock and adhere these over the corresponding stamped lily's. Attach to the circle edge (one piece is lifted up with Dimensionals).
13. Cut a few of the leaf pieces using Mint Macaron cardstock scraps and the Lily Pad dies.
14. Do the same on the inside of the left panel, so that it is a neat finish when the card is open (I didn't add any leaves on the inside bit, just the stamped and die cut flowers and the outline die cut flowers).



15. Attach the Blushing Bride cardstock pieces to the centre and left inside panels (both of these pieces are 9.2cm x 14.55cm).
16. Next attach the Lily Impressions DSP over the Blushing Bride cardstock on the left one, and the Whisper White cardstock over the Blushing Bride piece in the centre panel.
17. Add additional die cut embellishments as shown. I have also added some Coastal Cabana edging to the top and bottom on the front panel.
