Today we are making a quick and easy Christmas themed gift certificate or money holder. I have decorated mine with the Boughs of Holly DSP and Leaves of Holly Bundle, but the possibilities are endless!

Instructions:


1. Start with a piece of Crumb Cake cardstock 26cm x 21cm (8 1/2 x 10 1/4").
2. Stamp one side with a decorative stamp if you choose. I used one of the leaves from the Leaves of Holly stamp set and stamped in Crumb Cake.



3. Score at 7.5cm and 17.5cm (3" and 7") along the longest edge.
4. Fold the smallest section inwards first, and then the other section over the top.



5. Use a circle punch or die to cut a half circle at the end of the smallest section.
6. Place tear and tape either side of that piece. Remove the backing and fold inwards to form the pocket.



7. Using the very best Trio punch, cut the decorative corner on each side of the cover flap (Tip: when using the very best Trio punch, pay attention to which way the shape goes as explained in [THIS VIDEO](#)).



8. Cut two strips of Boughs of Holly DSP. One is 5cm wide (2") and the other is 5.5cm (2 1/4"). Adhere these two together with multipurpose glue.
9. Fold around the pocket and burnish the creases with a bone folder.
10. Trim what is needed off the ends, and add tear and tape to adhere.



11. Cut three holly leaves using the dies. I cut two from the DSP and one from Gold Glimmer Paper.
12. Adhere these to the belly band (with Tear and Tape adhesive) where they will be covered by the sentiment.



13. Stamp the sentiment from Brightest Glow stamp set in Evening Evergreen onto Shimmery White.
14. Cut out with the Stylish Shapes dies, and then cut the next size up square in Garden Green (if you don't have the dies you can just cut squares).
15. Adhere together, and to the Belly Band using Dimensionals.
16. Adhere a gold thread bow, two gold holly leaves and 3 red rhinestones as shown in the image below.
