Double Gatefold Card with Bellyband

Today we are making another fun / fancy fold card, this time using the Best Dressed Designer Series Paper. Perfect for all things girly.

Measurements

Base card

Start with a piece of cardstock 29.7cm (full length of an A4 sheet) x 10cm
Use the attached template for cutting and scoring guide.

DSP for decoration

6 pieces 14.7 x 4.7cm (2 each of 3 separate but coordinating designs)
1 coordinating piece of DSP 14.7cm x 9.5cm

Cardstock for inside of card


Whisper White piece 8.5cm x 13.8cm
Purple Posy 8.7cm x 14.0cm

Belly Band

Petal Pink cardstock 25cm x 4.0cm
1 coordinating piece of DSP 3.8cm x 15cm

Step by Step Instructions

1. Cut and score the base cardstock as per the template attached.
2. Cut the diagonal on each outside piece which is a direct line from the score line to a pencil mark 8cm from the bottom of the card.
3. Fold the first fold from either side outwards, and then the next fold from each side inwards as shown in the picture. Burnish the fold lines with your bone scorer.
4. Prepare your DSP pieces as per the cutting measurements above. There should be 1 large piece, and then 3 sets of 2 smaller pieces (each set the same pattern).
5. Choose the pieces which are going to be on the very front of the card (the two pieces that will fit where the diagonal cut has been made).
6. Trim this piece to 14cm in length. Make a pencil mark 7cm from the bottom of each piece on the right side for one piece, and the left side for the other piece.
7. Cut on the diagonal from the pencil mark to the top of the opposite side (make sure it has been trimmed to 14cm first or you will get the wrong angle)



- Adhere the largest piece of paper in the centre panel, one set of matching pieces on the panel either side (the handbag ones in my photo) and the angle pieces on the very ends.



- On the reverse side, adhere the remaining 2 pieces of paper on the panels second left and second right (as these will show behind the angle pieces when the card is folded).



- Adhere the Whisper White cardstock centre piece to the Purple Posy piece.
- Adhere over the DSP in the centre panel of the card.



- Cut out two of the perfume bottle images using paper snips.
- Adhere these to the right hand side bottom of the white cardstock.



- Punch a 2.5" cardstock circle from Petal Pink cardstock. Adhere a Pearlised doily over the top of this (I just adhered in the middle with snail). Adhere this to the back centre of the belly band strip.
- Adhere the DSP strip over the top with Snail or glue. Wrap around card and secure with Tear and Tape, Burnish folds with bone folder.
- Punch a small hole to the bottom right of the doily and attach one of the tassels (I tied it on using a small piece of bakers twine).
