Triangle Fun Fold Birthday Card

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Today we are making a Fun Fold birthday card, inspired by one I recently received from my OnStage travel buddy Sharon Davern (at rhapsodyincraft.blogspot.com). I'm also giving you a sneak peek of one of the gorgeous new papers coming in January.



Stampin' Up! supplies used:



Instructions:

1. Start with a side folding standard sized card (A4 or 8.5 x 11" cardstock sheet cut in half vertically and folded).
2. You will also need a piece of DSP at least as big as the front of your card. I am using the beautiful new Fancy Flora 6x6" DSP from the upcoming January to April 2023 Mini Catalogue.




3. Cut 1/2 of the right side of your card away on an angle as shown. The cut is from the centre score mark to the bottom right of the card.



4. Next we need two triangles slightly smaller than our card. The easiest way to this is to cut a rectangle of DSP 10.1cm x 14.45cm (or 5 1/4 x 4") and cut in half on an angle. However I cut mine slightly differently because I wanted to get the best use of the pattern on the new DSP. I cut one triangle from the top and another from the bottom so I got the most use from the DSP.



5. Attach these triangles of DSP (using glue or Stampin' Seal) to the inside top left of the left hand inside of the card, and to the outside of the right hand side of the card, so that when the right side is closed it looks like this.



6. Cut another piece of Orchid Oasis cardstock 21cm x 8cm (or 8 1/2" x 3"). Fold in half along the long side and burnish with a bone folder to make a mini card.
7. Cut a piece of Basic White or Shimmery White cardstock 10.2 x 7.8cm (or 4" x 2 3/4") and adhere to the inside of the mini card.
8. Cut a piece of DSP (one that isn't too pattern heavy) and adhere to the front of the mini card.



9. Adhere the back of the mini card to the inside left of the card, over the triangle of DSP. **Very important tip:** when you are lining up the placement, make sure the right hand side of the base card (the part that is not only a triangle) is able to sit flat once the mini card is closed. If you adhere the mini card too far over towards the right of the base card, the triangle part can't lay flat.



10. Stamp two flowers from the Artistically inked stamp set in Orchid Oasis, and two sets of leaves in Soft Succulent. Cut these out with paper snips and adhere to the top left of the front of the mini card (one flower is popped up with Dimensionals).
11. Add Wink of Stella if you would like some additional shine on the flowers.
12. Stamp the greeting in Balmy Blue onto Shimmery White. Cut angled ends and adhere to the base card.
13. Attach Iridescent Pastel Gems as shown.
