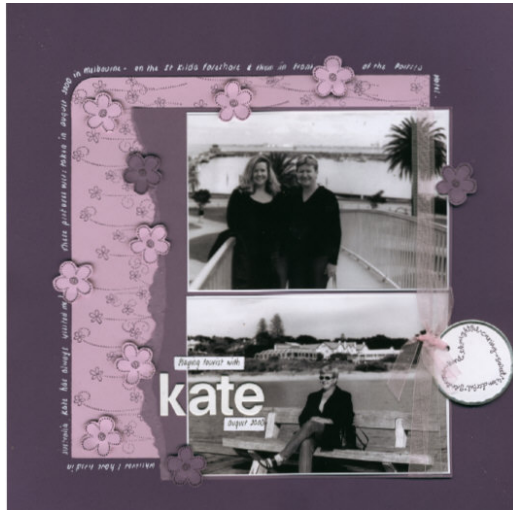


Stampin' Up! Layout Ideas *May 2007*

12 x 12 layout: 'Playing Tourist with Kate'

Ingredients

Photos: 2x 6x4"

Stampin' Up Cardstock: Elegant Eggplant 12 x 12; Pale Plum A4; Perfect Plum A4; White A4

Stampin' Up Stamps: 'Simply Said' stamp set

Stampin' Up! Ink: Elegant Eggplant, Basic Black

Other: Stampin' Up Silver and Pink organdy ribbon, Stampin' Up metal tag, white Uniball Signo pen, white chipboard letters

Method

- Cut a piece of Pale Plum cardstock 22cm high x 20.5cm wide and round the top left corner. Ink the edges with Elegant Eggplant ink.
- Cut a piece of Perfect Plum cardstock 21.2 cm high x 18.5 cm wide and tear the left side.
- Mount the photos on white cardstock leaving a 1mm border around each photo. Mount the photo's on the Perfect Plum cardstock aligning against the right side.
- Stamp the outline heart on the metal tag in basic black ink. Tie the ribbon around the right side of this block, and tie the tag to the ribbon (I used ribbon to do this after punching a hole in the tag).
- Stamp the daisy and stems image on the pale plum cardstock with Elegant Eggplant Ink and mount this block 4cm from the left hand top and side. Mount the Perfect Plum block allowing 1 cm to overhang on the right side and the bottom.
- Stamp the single daisy outline 8 times in basic black ink on the Pale Plum cardstock scraps and 3 times on the Perfect Plum cardstock scraps. Cut out and mount using dimensional tape, using the 3 darker Perfect plum flowers to form a visual triangle.
- Add the title and journal around the edge with the white gel pen.
